1	Deu 7:7	The Lord did not set His love on you nor choose you because you were more in number than any other people, for you were the least of all peoples;
2	Deu 7:8	but because the Lord loves you, and because He would keep the oath which He swore to your fathers, the Lord has brought you out with a mighty hand, and redeemed you from the house of bondage, from the hand of Pharaoh king of Egypt.
3	Deu 7:9	"Therefore know that the Lord your God, He is God, the faithful God who keeps covenant and mercy for a thousand generations with those who love Him and keep His commandments;
4	Deu 10:15	The Lord delighted only in your fathers, to love them; and He chose their descendants after them, you above all peoples, as it is this day.
5	Deu 10:17	For the Lord your God is God of gods and Lord of lords, the great God, mighty and awesome, who shows no partiality nor takes a bribe.
6	Deu 10:18	He administers justice for the fatherless and the widow, and loves the stranger, giving him food and clothing.
7	Deu 10:20	You shall fear the Lord your God; you shall serve Him, and to Him you shall hold fast, and take oaths in His name.
8	Deu 10:21	He is your praise, and He is your God, who has done for you these great and awesome things which your eyes have seen.
9	Deu 31:8	And the Lord, He is the One who goes before you. He will be with you, He will not leave you nor forsake you; do not fear nor be dismayed.
10	Joshua 1:9	Have I not commanded you? Be strong and of good courage; do not be afraid, nor be dismayed, for the Lord your God is with you wherever you go."
11	Joshua 23:11	Therefore take careful heed to yourselves, that you love the Lord your God.
12	1 Chr 16:34	Oh, give thanks to the Lord, for He is good! For His mercy endures forever.
13	Psalms 9:9	The Lord also will be a refuge for the oppressed, A refuge in times of trouble.
14	Psalms 11:7	For the Lord is righteous, He loves righteousness; His countenance beholds the upright.
15	Psalms 23:4	Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil; For You are with me; Your rod and Your staff, they comfort me.
16	Psalms 31:19	Oh, how great is Your goodness, which You have laid up for those who fear You, which You have prepared for those who trust in You in the presence of the sons of men!
17	Psalms 33:5	He loves righteousness and justice; The earth is full of the goodness of the Lord.
18	Psalms 33:12	Blessed <i>is</i> the nation whose God <i>is</i> the Lord, The people He has chosen as His own inheritance.

19	Psalm 33:18	Behold, the eye of the Lord is on those who fear Him, on those who hope in His mercy,
20	Psalm 36:7	How precious <i>is</i> Your lovingkindness, O God! Therefore the children of men put their trust under the shadow of Your wings.
21	Psalm 36:10	Oh, continue Your lovingkindness to those who know You, and Your righteousness to the upright in heart.
22	Psalms 37:28	For the Lord loves justice, and does not forsake His saints; They are preserved forever, but the descendants of the wicked shall be cut off.
23	Psalms 48:9	We have thought, O God, on Your lovingkindness, in the midst of Your temple.
24	Psalm 52:8	But I am like a green olive tree in the house of God; I trust in the mercy of God forever and ever.
25	Psalm 55:22	Cast your burden on the Lord, And He shall sustain you; He shall never permit the righteous to be moved.
26	Psalm 63:3	Because Your lovingkindness is better than life, my lips shall praise You.
27	Psalm 73:24	You will guide me with Your counsel, And afterward receive me to glory.
28	Psalm 86:15	But You, O Lord, are a God full of compassion, and gracious, longsuffering and abundant in mercy and truth.
29	Psalms 103:8	The Lord is merciful and gracious, slow to anger, and abounding in mercy.
30	Psalms 103:9	He will not always strive with us, nor will He keep His anger forever.
31	Psalms 103:10	He has not dealt with us according to our sins, nor punished us according to our iniquities.
32	Psalm 108:4	For Your mercy <i>is</i> great above the heavens, And Your truth reaches to the clouds.
33	Psalm 145:20	The Lord preserves all who love Him, but all the wicked He will destroy.
34	Psalm 146:8	The Lord opens <i>the eyes of</i> the blind; The Lord raises those who are bowed down; The Lord loves the righteous.
35	Prov 3:12	For whom the Lord loves He corrects, just as a father the son in whom he delights.
36	Prov 8:17	I love those who love me, and those who seek me diligently will find me.
37	Prov 15:9	The way of the wicked is an abomination to the Lord, But He loves him who follows righteousness.
38	Song of Solomon 2:4	He brought me to the banqueting house, And his banner over me was love.

39	Isaiah 40:31	But those who wait on the Lord, shall renew their strength; They shall mount up with wings like eagles, they shall run and not be weary, they shall walk and not faint.
40	Isaiah 43:4	Since you were precious in My sight, You have been honored, And I have loved you; Therefore I will give men for you, And people for your life.
41	Isaiah 49:15	Can a woman forget her nursing child, And not have compassion on the son of her womb? Surely they may forget, Yet I will not forget you.
42	Isaiah 49:16	See, I have inscribed you on the palms of My hands; your walls are continually before Me.
43	Isaiah 53:5	But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; The chastisement for our peace was upon Him, And by His stripes we are healed.
44	Isaiah 53:6	All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned, every one, to his own way; and the Lord has laid on Him the iniquity of us all.
45	Isaiah 53:11	He shall see the labor of His soul, and be satisfied. By His knowledge My righteous Servant shall justify many, For He shall bear their iniquities.
46	Isaiah 54:10	"For the mountains shall depart and the hills be removed, but My kindness shall not depart from you, nor shall My covenant of peace be removed," says the Lord, who has mercy on you.
47	Isaiah 55:7	Let the wicked forsake his way, and the unrighteous man his thoughts; Let him return to the Lord, and He will have mercy on him; And to our God, for He will abundantly pardon.
48	Jer 1:5	"Before I formed you in the womb I knew you; before you were born I sanctified you; I ordained you a prophet to the nations."
49	Jer 29:11	For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the Lord, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope.
50	Jer 31:3	The Lord has appeared of old to me, saying: "Yes, I have loved you with an everlasting love; Therefore with lovingkindness I have drawn you."
51	Lam 3:22	Through the Lord's mercies we are not consumed, Because His compassions fail not.
52	Lam 3:23	They are new every morning; Great is Your faithfulness.
53	Hosea 11:1	"When Israel <i>was</i> a child, I loved him, And out of Egypt I called My son.
54	Hosea 14:4	I will heal their backsliding, I will love them freely, for My anger has turned away from him.
55	Zeph 3:17	The Lord your God in your midst, The Mighty One, will save; He will rejoice over you with gladness, He will quiet you with His love, He will rejoice over you with singing.

56	Mal 1:2	"I have loved you," says the Lord. "Yet you say, 'In what way have You loved us?' Was not Esau Jacob's brother?" Says the Lord. "Yet Jacob I have loved;
57	Mal 3:17	"They shall be Mine," says the Lord of hosts, on the day that I make them My jewels. And I will spare them As a man spares his own son who serves him."
58	Mat 5: 44	But I say to you, love your enemies, bless those who curse you, do good to those who hate you, and pray for those who spitefully use you and persecute you,
59	Mat 5: 45	that you may be sons of your Father in heaven; for He makes His sun rise on the evil and on the good, and sends rain on the just and on the unjust.
60	Mat 7:11	If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father who is in heaven give good things to those who ask Him!
61	Mat 11:28	Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.
62	Mat 11:29	Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls.
63	Mat 22:37	Jesus said to him, "'You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind."
64	Luke 10:27	So he answered and said, "'You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your strength, and with all your mind, ^[a] and 'your neighbor as yourself.'"
65	Luke 12:6	Are not five sparrows sold for two copper coins? And not one of them is forgotten before God.
66	Luke 12:7	But the very hairs of your head are all numbered. Do not fear therefore; you are of more value than many sparrows.
67	Luke 19:10	for the Son of Man has come to seek and to save that which was lost."
68	John 3:16	For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.
69	John 3:17	For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him might be saved.
70	John 5:24	"Most assuredly, I say to you, he who hears My word and believes in Him who sent Me has everlasting life, and shall not come into judgment, but has passed from death into life.
71	John 10:3	To him the doorkeeper opens, and the sheep hear his voice; and he calls his own sheep by name and leads them out.
72	John 10:9	I am the door. If anyone enters by Me, he will be saved, and will go in and out and find pasture.
73	John 10:10	The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly.

74	John 10:11	I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd gives His life for the sheep.
75	John 10:14	I am the good shepherd; and I know My sheep, and am known by My own.
76	John 10:15	As the Father knows Me, even so I know the Father; and I lay down My life for the sheep.
77	John 10:16	And other sheep I have which are not of this fold; them also I must bring, and they will hear My voice; and there will be one flock and one shepherd.
78	John 10:17	Therefore My Father loves Me, because I lay down My life that I may take it again.
79	John 10:18	No one takes it from Me, but I lay it down of Myself. I have power to lay it down, and I have power to take it again. This command I have received from My Father.
80	John 10:27	My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me.
81	John 10: 28	And I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; neither shall anyone snatch them out of My hand.
82	John 13:1	Now before the Feast of the Passover, when Jesus knew that His hour had come that He should depart from this world to the Father, having loved His own who were in the world, He loved them to the end.
83	John 13: 34	A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another; as I have loved you, that you also love one another.
84	John 13:35	By this all will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another.
85	John 14:15	"If you love Me, keep My commandments.
86	John 14:21	He who has My commandments and keeps them, it is he who loves Me. And he who loves Me will be loved by My Father, and I will love him and manifest Myself to him."
87	John 14:23	Jesus answered and said to him, "If anyone loves Me, he will keep My word; and My Father will love him, and We will come to him and make Our home with him.
88	John 14:27	Peace I leave with you, My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.
89	John 15:9	As the Father loved Me, I also have loved you; abide in My love.
90	John 15:10	If you keep My commandments, you will abide in My love, just as I have kept My Father's commandments and abide in His love.
91	John 15:12	This is My commandment, that you love one another as I have loved you.
92	John 15:13	Greater love has no one than this, than to lay down one's life for his friends.
93	John 15:16	You did not choose Me, but I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit, and <i>that</i> your fruit should remain, that whatever you ask the Father in My name He may give you.

94	John 16:27	for the Father Himself loves you, because you have loved Me, and have believed that I came forth from God.
95	John 17:6	I have manifested Your name to the men whom You have given Me out of the world. They were Yours, You gave them to Me, and they have kept Your word.
96	John 17:20	I do not pray for these alone, but also for those who will believe in Me through their word;
97	John 17:21	that they all may be one, as You, Father, are in Me, and I in You; that they also may be one in Us, that the world may believe that You sent Me.
98	John 17:22	And the glory which You gave Me I have given them, that they may be one just as We are one:
99	John 17:23	I in them, and You in Me; that they may be made perfect in one, and that the world may know that You have sent Me, and have loved them as You have loved Me.
100	John 17:24	"Father, I desire that they also whom You gave Me may be with Me where I am, that they may behold My glory which You have given Me; for You loved Me before the foundation of the world.
101	Acts 2:23	Him, being delivered by the determined purpose and foreknowledge of God, you have taken by lawless hands, have crucified, and put to death;
102	Rom 5:2	Through whom also we have access by faith into this grace in which we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God.
103	Rom 5:5	Now hope does not disappoint, because the love of God has been poured out in our hearts by the Holy Spirit who was given to us.
104	Rom 5:6	For when we were still without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly.
105	Rom 5:8	But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.
106	Rom 6:23	For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.
107	Rom 8:28	And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are the called according to His purpose.
108	Rom 8:30	Moreover whom He predestined, these He also called; whom He called, these He also justified; and whom He justified, these He also glorified.
109	Rom 8:32	He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how shall He not with Him also freely give us all things?
110	Rom 8:37	Yet in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us.
111	Rom 8:38	For I am persuaded that neither death nor life, nor angels nor principalities nor powers, nor things present nor things to come,

112	Rom 8:39	nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate us from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.
113	Rom 9:16	So then <i>it is</i> not of him who wills, nor of him who runs, but of God who shows mercy.
114	Rom 12:9	Let love be without hypocrisy. Abhor what is evil. Cling to what is good.
115	Rom 13:8	Owe no one anything except to love one another, for he who loves another has fulfilled the law.
116	Rom 15:13	Now may the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that you may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.
117	1 Cor 1:9	God <i>is</i> faithful, by whom you were called into the fellowship of His Son, Jesus Christ our Lord.
118	1 Cor 2:9	But as it is written: "Eye has not seen, nor ear heard, Nor have entered into the heart of man The things which God has prepared for those who love Him."
119	1 Cor 8:3	But if anyone loves God, this one is known by Him.
120	1 Cor 10:13	No temptation has overtaken you except such as is common to man; but God is faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will also make the way of escape, that you may be able to bear it.
121	1 Cor 13:13	And now abide faith, hope, love, these three; but the greatest of these <i>is</i> love.
122	2 Cor 5:14	For the love of Christ compels us, because we judge thus: that if One died for all, then all died;
123	2 Cor 9:7	So let each one give as he purposes in his heart, not grudgingly or of necessity; for God loves a cheerful giver.
124	2 Cor 9:8	And God is able to make all grace abound toward you, that you, always having all sufficiency in all things, may have an abundance for every good work.
125	2 Cor 12:9	And He said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for My strength is made perfect in weakness." Therefore most gladly I will rather boast in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.
126	2 Cor 13:14	The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Spirit be with you all. Amen.
127	Gal 2:20	I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me.
128	Gal 5:13	For you, brethren, have been called to liberty; only do not use liberty as an opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve one another.
129	Eph 1:3	Blessed <i>be</i> the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly <i>places</i> in Christ,

130	Eph 1:4	just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before Him in love,
131	Eph 1: 5	having predestined us to adoption as sons by Jesus Christ to Himself, according to the good pleasure of His will,
132	Eph 1:6	to the praise of the glory of His grace, by which He made us accepted in the Beloved.
133	Eph 2:4	But God, who is rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us,
134	Eph 2:5	even when we were dead in trespasses, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved),
135	Eph 2:6	and raised <i>us</i> up together, and made <i>us</i> sit together in the heavenly <i>places</i> in Christ Jesus,
136	Eph 2:7	that in the ages to come He might show the exceeding riches of His grace in <i>His</i> kindness toward us in Christ Jesus.
137	Eph 2:8	For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God,
138	Eph 3:17	that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith; that you, being rooted and grounded in love,
139	Eph 3:18	may be able to comprehend with all the saints what is the width and length and depth and height
140	Eph 3:19	to know the love of Christ which passes knowledge; that you may be filled with all the fullness of God.
141	Eph 5:2	And walk in love, as Christ also has loved us and given Himself for us, an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweet-smelling aroma.
142	Eph 5:25	Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself for her,
143	Eph 5:26	that He might sanctify and cleanse her with the washing of water by the word,
144	Eph 5:27	that He might present her to Himself a glorious church, not having spot or wrinkle or any such thing, but that she should be holy and without blemish.
145	Eph 5:29	For no one ever hated his own flesh, but nourishes and cherishes it, just as the Lord does the church.
146	Phil 4:19	And my God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus.
147	Col 1:21	And you, who once were alienated and enemies in your mind by wicked works, yet now He has reconciled

148	Col 3:12	Therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, put on tender mercies, kindness, humility, meekness, longsuffering;
149	Col 3:13	bearing with one another, and forgiving one another, if anyone has a complaint against another; even as Christ forgave you, so you also must do.
150	2 Thes 2:13	But we are bound to give thanks to God always for you, brethren beloved by the Lord, because God from the beginning chose you for salvation through sanctification by the Spirit and belief in the truth,
151	2 Thes 2:16	Now may our Lord Jesus Christ Himself, and our God and Father, who has loved us and given <i>us</i> everlasting consolation and good hope by grace,
152	1 Tim 1:14	And the grace of our Lord was exceedingly abundant, with faith and love which are in Christ Jesus.
153	1 Tim 1:15	This is a faithful saying and worthy of all acceptance, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners, of whom I am chief.
154	2 Tim 1:7	For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind.
155	2 Tim 1:9	who has saved us and called <i>us</i> with a holy calling, not according to our works, but according to His own purpose and grace which was given to us in Christ Jesus before time began,
156	Titus 3:4	But when the kindness and the love of God our Savior toward man appeared,
157	Titus 3:5	not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to His mercy He saved us, through the washing of regeneration and renewing of the Holy Spirit,
158	Heb 1:9	You have loved righteousness and hated lawlessness; therefore God, Your God, has anointed You with the oil of gladness more than Your companions.
159	Heb 9:12	Not with the blood of goats and calves, but with His own blood He entered the Most Holy Place once for all, having obtained eternal redemption.
160	Heb 10:17	then He adds, "Their sins and their lawless deeds I will remember no more."
161	Heb 12:6	For whom the Lord loves He chastens, And scourges every son whom He receives."
162	Heb 13:5	Let your conduct be without covetousness; be content with such things as you have. For He Himself has said, "I will never leave you nor forsake you."
163	James 1:12	Blessed is the man who endures temptation; for when he has been approved, he will receive the crown of life which the Lord has promised to those who love Him.
164	James 1:17	Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and comes down from the Father of lights, with whom there is no variation or shadow of turning.
165	1 Peter 1:5	who are kept by the power of God through faith for salvation ready to be revealed in the last time.

166	1 Peter 2:3	if indeed you have tasted that the Lord <i>is</i> gracious.
167	1 Peter 2:4	Coming to Him <i>as to</i> a living stone, rejected indeed by men, but chosen by God <i>and</i> precious,
168	1 Peter 2:5	you also, as living stones, are being built up a spiritual house, a holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ.
169	1 Peter 2:24	who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, having died to sins, might live for righteousness—by whose stripes you were healed.
170	1 Peter 5:7	casting all your care upon Him, for He cares for you.
171	2 Pet 3:9	The Lord is not slack concerning His promise, as some count slackness, but is longsuffering toward us, not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance.
172	1 John 1:9	If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
173	1 John 2:5	But whoever keeps His word, truly the love of God is perfected in him. By this we know that we are in Him.
174	1 John 3:1	Behold what manner of love the Father has bestowed on us, that we should be called children of God! Therefore the world does not know us, because it did not know Him.
175	1 John 3:16	By this we know love, because He laid down His life for us. And we also ought to lay down our lives for the brethren.
176	1 John 3:17	But whoever has this world's goods, and sees his brother in need, and shuts up his heart from him, how does the love of God abide in him?
177	1 John 3:22	And whatever we ask we receive from Him, because we keep His commandments and do those things that are pleasing in His sight.
178	1 John 3:23	And this is His commandment: that we should believe on the name of His Son Jesus Christ and love one another, as He gave us commandment.
179	1 John 3:24	Now he who keeps His commandments abides in Him, and He in him. And by this we know that He abides in us, by the Spirit whom He has given us.
180	1 John 4:7	Beloved, let us love one another, for love is of God; and everyone who loves is born of God and knows God.
181	1 John 4:8	He who does not love does not know God, for God is love.
182	1 John 4:9	In this the love of God was manifested toward us, that God has sent His only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through Him.
183	1 John 4:10	In this is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins.
184	1 John 4:11	Beloved, if God so loved us, we also ought to love one another.

185	1 John 4:12	No one has seen God at any time. If we love one another, God abides in us, and His love has been perfected in us.
186	1 John 4:13	By this we know that we abide in Him, and He in us, because He has given us of His Spirit.
187	1 John 4:14	And we have seen and testify that the Father has sent the Son as Savior of the world.
188	1 John 4:15	Whoever confesses that Jesus is the Son of God, God abides in him, and he in God.
189	1 John 4:16	And we have known and believed the love that God has for us. God is love, and he who abides in love abides in God, and God in him.
190	1 John 4:17	Love has been perfected among us in this: that we may have boldness in the day of judgment; because as He is, so are we in this world.
191	1 John 4:18	There is no fear in love; but perfect love casts out fear, because fear involves torment. But he who fears has not been made perfect in love.
192	1 John 4:19	We love Him because He first loved us.
193	1 John 4:21	And this commandment we have from Him: that he who loves God must love his brother also.
194	1 John 5:3	For this is the love of God, that we keep His commandments. And His commandments are not burdensome.
195	2 John 1:6	This is love, that we walk according to His commandments. This is the commandment, that as you have heard from the beginning, you should walk in it.
196	Jude 21	keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life.
197	Rev 1:5	and from Jesus Christ, the faithful witness, the firstborn from the dead, and the ruler over the kings of the earth. To Him who loved us and washed us from our sins in His own blood
198	Rev 3:19	As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten. Therefore be zealous and repent.
199	Rev 3:20	Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears My voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and dine with him, and he with Me.
200	Rev 21:4	And God will wipe away every tear from their eyes; there shall be no more death, nor sorrow, nor crying. There shall be no more pain, for the former things have passed away.
