39	Psalm	147:5	Great is our Lord, and mighty in power; His understanding is infinite.
40	Proverbs	3:5	Trust in the Lord with all your heart, And lean not on your own understanding;
41	Proverbs	3:6	In all your ways acknowledge Him, And He shall direct your paths.
42	Proverbs	3:21	My son, let them not depart from your eyes- Keep sound wisdom and discretion;
43	Proverbs	3:22	So they will be life to your soul And grace to your neck.
44	Proverbs	3:23	Then you will walk safely in your way, And your foot will not stumble.

45	Proverbs	3:24	When you lie down, you will not be afraid; Yes, you will lie down and your sleep will be sweet.
46	Proverbs	3:25	Do not be afraid of sudden terror, Nor of trouble from the wicked when it comes;

48	Proverbs	12:25	Anxiety in the heart of man causes depression, But a good word makes it glad.
49	Proverbs	28:13	He who covers his sins will not prosper, But whoever confesses and forsakes them will have mercy.
50	Proverbs	28:14	Happy is the man who is always reverent, But he who hardens his heart will fall into calamity.
51	Proverbs	29:25	The fear of man brings a snare, But whoever trusts in the Lord shall be safe.
52	Isaiah	35:3	Strengthen the weak hands, And make firm the feeble knees.
53	Isaiah	35:4	Say to those who are fearful-hearted, "Be strong, do not fear! Behold, your God will come with vengeance, With the recompense of God; He will come and save you.
54	Isaiah	40:30	Even the youths shall faint and be weary, And the young men shall utterly fall,
55	Isaiah	40:31	But those who wait on the Lord Shall renew their strength; They shall mount up with wings like eagles, They shall run and not be weary, They shall walk and not faint.
56	Isaiah	41:10	Fear not, for I am with you; Be not dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you, Yes, I will help you, I will uphold you with My righteous right hand.'

61	Isaiah	43:2	When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; And through the rivers, they shall not overflow you. When you walk through the fire, you shall not be burned, Nor shall the flame scorch you.
62	Isaiah	49:15	Can a woman forget her nursing child, And not have compassion on the son of her womb? Surely they may forget, Yet I will not forget you.
63	Isaiah	49:16	See, I have inscribed you on the palms of My hands; Your walls are continually before Me.
64	Isaiah	50:7	For the Lord God will help Me; Therefore I will not be disgraced;

			Therefore I have set My face like a flint, And I know that I will not be ashamed.
65	Isaiah	50:8	He is near who justifies Me; Who will contend with Me? Let us stand together. Who is My adversary? Let him come near Me.
66	Isaiah	50:9	Surely the Lord God will help Me; Who is he who will condemn Me? Indeed they will all grow old like a garment; The moth will eat them up.
67	Isaiah	54:17	No weapon formed against you shall prosper, And every tongue which rises against you in judgment You shall condemn. This is the heritage of the servants of the Lord, And their righteousness is from Me," Says the Lord.
68	Jeremiah	29:11	For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the Lord, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope.
69	Lamentations	3:22	Through the Lord's mercies we are not consumed, Because His compassions fail not.
70	Lamentations	3:23	They are new every morning; Great is Your faithfulness.
71	Lamentations	3:24	"The Lord is my portion," says my soul, "Therefore I hope in Him!"
72	Lamentations	3:57	You drew near on the day I called on You, And said, "Do not fear!"
73	Micah	7:18	Who is a God like You, Pardoning iniquity And passing over the transgression of the remnant of His heritage? He does not retain His anger forever, Because He delights in mercy.
74	Micah	7:19	He will again have compassion on us, And will subdue our iniquities. You will cast all our sins into the depths of the sea.
75	Zephaniah	3:17	The Lord your God in your midst, The Mighty One, will save; He will rejoice over you with gladness, He will quiet you with His love, He will rejoice over you with singing.
76	Matthew	6:34	Therefore do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about its own things. Sufficient for the day is its own trouble.
77	Matthew	10:28	And do not fear those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul. But rather fear Him who is able to destroy both soul and body in hell.
78	Matthew	11:28	Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.
79	Matthew	11:29	Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls.
80	Matthew	11:30	For My yoke is easy and My burden is light.
81	Luke	12:6	Are not five sparrows sold for two copper coins? And not one of them is forgotten before God.
82	Luke	12:7	But the very hairs of your head are all numbered. Do not fear therefore; you are of more value than many sparrows.
83	Luke	12:22	Then He said to His disciples, "Therefore I say to you, do not worry about your life, what you will eat; nor about the body, what you will put on.
84	Luke	12:23	Life is more than food, and the body is more than clothing.
85	Luke	12:24	Consider the ravens, for they neither sow nor reap, which have

			neither storehouse nor barn; and God feeds them. Of how much more value are you than the birds?
86	Luke	12:25	And which of you by worrying can add one cubit to his stature?
87	Luke	12:26	If you then are not able to do the least, why are you anxious for the rest?
88	John	3:17	For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him might be saved.
89	John	14:1	Let not your heart be troubled; you believe in God, believe also in Me.
90	John	14:2	In My Father's house are many mansions; if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you.
91	John	14:16	And I will pray the Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may abide with you forever-
92	John	14:17	the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees Him nor knows Him; but you know Him, for He dwells with you and will be in you.
93	John	14:18	I will not leave you orphans; I will come to you.
94	John	14:27	Peace I leave with you, My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.
95	John	15:18	If the world hates you, you know that it hated Me before it hated you.
96	John	15:19	If you were of the world, the world would love its own. Yet because you are not of the world, but I chose you out of the world, therefore the world hates you.
97	Acts	17:30	Truly, these times of ignorance God overlooked, but now commands all men everywhere to repent,
98	Acts	17:31	because He has appointed a day on which He will judge the world in righteousness by the Man whom He has ordained. He has given assurance of this to all by raising Him from the dead.
99	Acts	18:9	Now the Lord spoke to Paul in the night by a vision, "Do not be afraid, but speak, and do not keep silent;
100	Acts	18:10	for I am with you, and no one will attack you to hurt you; for I have many people in this city.
101	Romans	5:3	And not only that, but we also glory in tribulations, knowing that tribulation produces perseverance;
102	Romans	5:4	and perseverance, character; and character, hope.
103	Romans	5:5	Now hope does not disappoint, because the love of God has been poured out in our hearts by the Holy Spirit who was given to us.
104	Romans	8:1	There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus, who do not walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit.
105	Romans	8:2	For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has made me free from the law of sin and death.
106	Romans	8:3	For what the law could not do in that it was weak through the

			flesh, God did by sending His own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, on account of sin: He condemned sin in the flesh,
107	Romans	8:4	that the righteous requirement of the law might be fulfilled in us who do not walk according to the flesh but according to the Spirit.
108	Romans	8:14	For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God.
109	Romans	8:15	For you did not receive the spirit of bondage again to fear, but you received the Spirit of adoption by whom we cry out, "Abba, Father.
110	Romans	8:16	The Spirit Himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God,
111	Romans	8:17	and if children, then heirs—heirs of God and joint heirs with Christ, if indeed we suffer with Him, that we may also be glorified together.
112	Romans	8:26	Likewise the Spirit also helps in our weaknesses. For we do not know what we should pray for as we ought, but the Spirit Himself makes intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered.
113	Romans	8:27	Now He who searches the hearts knows what the mind of the Spirit is, because He makes intercession for the saints according to the will of God.
114	Romans	8:28	And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are the called according to His purpose.
115	Romans	8:31	What then shall we say to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us?
116	Romans	8:32	He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how shall He not with Him also freely give us all things?
117	Romans	8:33	Who shall bring a charge against God's elect? It is God who justifies.
118	Romans	8:34	Who is he who condemns? It is Christ who died, and furthermore is also risen, who is even at the right hand of God, who also makes intercession for us.
119	Romans	8:35	Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword?
120	Romans	8:37	Yet in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us.
121	Romans	8:38	For I am persuaded that neither death nor life, nor angels nor principalities nor powers, nor things present nor things to come,
122	Romans	8:39	nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate us from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.
123	Romans	11:29	For the gifts and the calling of God are irrevocable.
124	1 Corinthians	2:9	But as it is written: "Eye has not seen, nor ear heard, Nor have entered into the heart of man The things which God has prepared for those who love Him."
125	1 Corinthians	10:13	No temptation has overtaken you except such as is common to

			man; but God is faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will also make the way of escape, that you may be able to bear it.
126	1 Corinthians	15:57	But thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.
127	1 Corinthians	15:58	Therefore, my beloved brethren, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that your labor is not in vain in the Lord.
128	2 Corinthians	1:3	Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies and God of all comfort,
129	2 Corinthians	1:4	who comforts us in all our tribulation, that we may be able to comfort those who are in any trouble, with the comfort with which we ourselves are comforted by God.
130	2 Corinthians	3:4	And we have such trust through Christ toward God.
131	2 Corinthians	3:5	Not that we are sufficient of ourselves to think of anything as being from ourselves, but our sufficiency is from God,
132	2 Corinthians	3:6	who also made us sufficient as ministers of the new covenant, not of the letter but of the Spirit; for the letter kills, but the Spirit gives life.
133	2 Corinthians	10:3	For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war according to the flesh.
134	2 Corinthians	10:4	For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal but mighty in God for pulling down strongholds,
135	2 Corinthians	10:5	casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ,
136	2 Corinthians	10:6	and being ready to punish all disobedience when your obedience is fulfilled.
137	2 Corinthians	12:9	And He said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for My strength is made perfect in weakness." Therefore most gladly I will rather boast in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.
138	2 Corinthians	12:10	Therefore I take pleasure in infirmities, in reproaches, in needs, in persecutions, in distresses, for Christ's sake. For when I am weak, then I am strong.
139	Philippians	1:6	Being confident of this very thing, that He who has begun a good work in you will complete it until the day of Jesus Christ;
140	Philippians	4:6	Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God;
141	Philippians	4:7	and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.
142	Philippians	4:8	Finally, brethren, whatever things are true, whatever things are noble, whatever things are just, whatever things are pure, whatever things are lovely, whatever things are of good report, if

			there is any virtue and if there is anything praiseworthy—meditate on these things.
143	Philippians	4:13	I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me.
144	Philippians	4:19	And my God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus.
145	Colossians	3:15	And let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to which also you were called in one body; and be thankful.
146	Colossians	3:16	Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom, teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord.
147	Colossians	3:17	And whatever you do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through Him.
148	2 Timothy	1:7	For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind.
149	Hebrews	2:11	For both He who sanctifies and those who are being sanctified are all of one, for which reason He is not ashamed to call them brethren,
150	Hebrews	2:12	saying: "I will declare Your name to My brethren; In the midst of the assembly I will sing praise to You."
151	Hebrews	4:14	Seeing then that we have a great High Priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession.
152	Hebrews	4:15	For we do not have a High Priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but was in all points tempted as we are, yet without sin.
153	Hebrews	4:16	Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need.
154	Hebrews	8:1	Now this is the main point of the things we are saying: We have such a High Priest, who is seated at the right hand of the throne of the Majesty in the heavens,
155	Hebrews	8:2	a Minister of the sanctuary and of the true tabernacle which the Lord erected, and not man.
156	Hebrews	11:6	But without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.
157	Hebrews	12:1	Therefore we also, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which so easily ensnares us, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us,
158	Hebrews	12:2	looking unto Jesus, the author and finisher of our faith, who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.
159	Hebrews	12:3	For consider Him who endured such hostility from sinners against Himself, lest you become weary and discouraged in your souls.
160	Hebrews	12:4	You have not yet resisted to bloodshed, striving against sin.



161	Hebrews	12:5	And you have forgotten the exhortation which speaks to you as to sons: "My son, do not despise the chastening of the Lord, Nor be discouraged when you are rebuked by Him;
162	Hebrews	12:6	For whom the Lord loves He chastens, And scourges every son whom He receives.
163	Hebrews	12:7	If you endure chastening, God deals with you as with sons; for what son is there whom a father does not chasten?
164	Hebrews	12:8	But if you are without chastening, of which all have become partakers, then you are illegitimate and not sons.
165	Hebrews	13:5	Let your conduct be without covetousness; be content with such things as you have. For He Himself has said, "I will never leave you nor forsake you.
166	Hebrews	13:6	So we may boldly say: "The Lord is my helper; I will not fear. What can man do to me?"
167	James	1:2	My brethren, count it all joy when you fall into various trials,
168	James	1:3	knowing that the testing of your faith produces patience.
169	James	1:4	But let patience have its perfect work, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking nothing.
170	James	1:5	If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives to all liberally and without reproach, and it will be given to him.
171	James	1:6	But let him ask in faith, with no doubting, for he who doubts is like a wave of the sea driven and tossed by the wind.
172	James	5:15	And the prayer of faith will save the one who is sick, and the Lord will raise him up. And if he has committed sins, he will be forgiven.
173	James	5:16	Confess your trespasses to one another, and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much.
174	James	5:17	Elijah was a man with a nature like ours, and he prayed earnestly that it would not rain; and it did not rain on the land for three years and six months.
175	James	5:18	And he prayed again, and the heaven gave rain, and the earth produced its fruit.
176	1 Peter	2:2	Therefore, laying aside all malice, all deceit, hypocrisy, envy, and all evil speaking,
177	1 Peter	2:3	as newborn babes, desire the pure milk of the word, that you may grow thereby,
178	1 Peter	2:4	if indeed you have tasted that the Lord is gracious.
179	1 Peter	2:9	But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light;
180	1 Peter	2:10	who once were not a people but are now the people of God, who had not obtained mercy but now have obtained mercy.
181	1 Peter	2:15	For this is the will of God, that by doing good you may put to silence the ignorance of foolish men-

182	1 Peter	2:16	as free, yet not using liberty as a cloak for vice, but as bondservants of God.
183	1 Peter	2:17	Honor all people. Love the brotherhood. Fear God. Honor the king.
184	1 Peter	5:6	Therefore humble yourselves under the mighty hand of God, that He may exalt you in due time,
185	1 Peter	5:7	casting all your care upon Him, for He cares for you.
186	1 Peter	5:8	Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil walks about like a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour.
187	1 Peter	5:9	Resist him, steadfast in the faith, knowing that the same sufferings are experienced by your brotherhood in the world.
188	1 Peter	5:10	But may the God of all grace, who called us to His eternal glory by Christ Jesus, after you have suffered a while, perfect, establish, strengthen, and settle you.
189	1 Peter	5:11	To Him be the glory and the dominion forever and ever. Amen
190	2 Peter	3:8	But, beloved, do not forget this one thing, that with the Lord one day is as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day.
191	2 Peter	3:9	The Lord is not slack concerning His promise, as some count slackness, but is longsuffering toward us, not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance.
192	1 John	1:8	If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us.
193	1 John	1:9	If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
194	1 John	2:1	My little children, these things I write to you, so that you may not sin. And if anyone sins, we have an Advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous.
195	1 John	2:2	And He Himself is the propitiation for our sins, and not for ours only but also for the whole world.
196	Revelation	2:10	Do not fear any of those things which you are about to suffer. Indeed, the devil is about to throw some of you into prison, that you may be tested, and you will have tribulation ten days. Be faithful until death, and I will give you the crown of life
197	Revelation	3:11	Behold, I am coming quickly! Hold fast what you have, that no one may take your crown.
198	Revelation	21:4	And God will wipe away every tear from their eyes; there shall be no more death, nor sorrow, nor crying. There shall be no more pain, for the former things have passed away.
199	Revelation	22:11	He who is unjust, let him be unjust still; he who is filthy, let him be filthy still; he who is righteous, let him be righteous still; he who is holy, let him be holy still.
200	Revelation	22:12	And behold, I am coming quickly, and My reward is with Me, to give to every one according to his work.
