

1	Psalm 3:8	Salvation belongs to the Lord. Your blessing is upon Your people.
2	Psalm 18:2	The Lord is my rock and my fortress and my deliverer; My God, my strength, in whom I will trust; My shield and the horn of my salvation, my stronghold.
3	Psalm 32:1	Blessed is he whose transgression is forgiven, whose sin is covered.
4	Psalm 34:22	The Lord redeems the soul of His servants, and none of those who trust in Him shall be condemned.
5	Psalm 37:39	But the salvation of the righteous is from the Lord; He is their strength in the time of trouble.
6	Psalms 149:4	For the Lord takes pleasure in His people; He will beautify the humble with salvation.
7	Isaiah 12:2	Behold, God is my salvation, I will trust and not be afraid; 'For Yah, the Lord, is my strength and song; He also has become my salvation.'
8	Isaiah 45:21	Tell and bring forth your case; Yes, let them take counsel together. Who has declared this from ancient time? Who has told it from that time? Have not I, the Lord? And there is no other God besides Me, A just God and a Savior; There is none besides Me.
9	Isaiah 45:22	"Look to Me, and be saved, All you ends of the earth! For I am God, and there is no other.
10	Isaiah 51:1	"Listen to Me, you who follow after righteousness, you who seek the Lord: Look to the rock from which you were hewn, and to the hole of the pit from which you were dug.
11	Isaiah 51:6	Lift up your eyes to the heavens, and look on the earth beneath. For the heavens will vanish away like smoke, the earth will grow old like a garment, and those who dwell in it will die in like manner; But My salvation will be forever, and My righteousness will not be abolished.
12	Isaiah 51:7	"Listen to Me, you who know righteousness, you people in whose heart is My law: Do not fear the reproach of men, nor be afraid of their insults.
13	Isaiah 51:8	For the moth will eat them up like a garment, and the worm will eat them like wool; But My righteousness will be forever, and My salvation from generation to generation."
14	Isaiah 55:6	Seek the Lord while He may be found, Call upon Him while He is near.
15	Isaiah 55:7	Let the wicked forsake his way, and the unrighteous man his thoughts; Let him return to the Lord, and He will have mercy on him; and to our God, for He will abundantly pardon.
16	Isaiah 59:1	Behold, the Lord's hand is not shortened, that it cannot save; Nor His ear heavy, that it cannot hear.
17	Isaiah 59:2	But your iniquities have separated you from your God; And your sins have hidden His face from you, so that He will not hear.
18	Isaiah 64:6	But we are all like an unclean thing, and all our righteousnesses are like filthy rags; We all fade as a leaf, and our iniquities, like the wind, have taken us away.
19	Jeremiah 3:23	Truly, in vain is salvation hoped for from the hills, and from the multitude of mountains; Truly, in the Lord our God Is the salvation of Israel.
20	Mathew 1:20	But while he thought about these things, behold, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream, saying, "Joseph, son of David, do not be afraid to take to you Mary your wife, for that which is conceived in her is of the Holy Spirit.

21	Matthew 1:21	And she will bring forth a Son, and you shall call His name Jesus, for He will save His people from their sins."
22	Matthew 1:22	So all this was done that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the Lord through the prophet, saying:
23	Matthew 1:23	"Behold, the virgin shall be with child, and bear a Son, and they shall call His name Immanuel," which is translated, "God with us."
24	Mathew 18:3	And said, "Assuredly, I say to you, unless you are converted and become as little children, you will by no means enter the kingdom of heaven.
25	John 1:12	But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name:
26	John 1:13	who were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God.
27	John 3:3	Jesus answered and said to him, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God."
28	John 3:5	Jesus answered, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God.
29	John 3:16	For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.
30	John 3:17	For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him might be saved.
31	John 3:18	"He who believes in Him is not condemned; but he who does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God.
32	John 3:36	He who believes in the Son has everlasting life; and he who does not believe the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God abides on him.
33	John 6:35	And Jesus said to them, "I am the bread of life. He who comes to Me shall never hunger, and he who believes in Me shall never thirst.
34	John 6:38	For I have come down from heaven, not to do My own will, but the will of Him who sent Me.
35	John 6:40	And this is the will of Him who sent Me, that everyone who sees the Son and believes in Him may have everlasting life; and I will raise him up at the last day."
36	John 10:9	I am the door. If anyone enters by Me, he will be saved, and will go in and out and find pasture.
37	John 10:27	My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me.
38	John 10:28	And I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; neither shall anyone snatch them out of My hand.
39	John 14:6	Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.
40	John 17:1	Jesus spoke these words, lifted up His eyes to heaven, and said: "Father, the hour has come. Glorify Your Son, that Your Son also may glorify You,
41	John 17:2	as You have given Him authority over all flesh, that He should give eternal life to as many as You have given Him.
42	John 17:3	And this is eternal life, that they may know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent.
43	Acts 4:11	This is the 'stone which was rejected by you builders, which has become the chief cornerstone'.
44	Acts 4:12	Nor is there salvation in any other, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved.

45	Acts 5:29	But Peter and the other apostles answered and said: "We ought to obey God rather than men.
46	Acts 5:30	The God of our fathers raised up Jesus whom you murdered by hanging on a tree.
47	Acts 5:31	Him God has exalted to His right hand to be Prince and Savior, to give repentance to Israel and forgiveness of sins.
48	Acts 5:32	And we are His witnesses to these things, and so also is the Holy Spirit whom God has given to those who obey Him."
49	Acts 16:30	And he brought them out and said, "Sirs, what must I do to be saved?"
50	Acts 16:31	So they said, "Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and you will be saved, you and your household."
51	Acts 17:30	Truly, these times of ignorance God overlooked, but now commands all men everywhere to repent,
52	Acts 17:31	because He has appointed a day on which He will judge the world in righteousness by the Man whom He has ordained. He has given assurance of this to all by raising Him from the dead.
53	Romans 1:16	For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes, for the Jew first and also for the Greek.
54	Romans 1:17	For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith to faith; as it is written, "The just shall live by faith."
55	Romans 3:23	For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,
56	Romans 3:24	Being justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus,
57	Romans 3:25	Whom God set forth as a propitiation by His blood, through faith, to demonstrate His righteousness, because in His forbearance God had passed over the sins that were previously committed,
58	Romans 3:26	to demonstrate at the present time His righteousness, that He might be just and the justifier of the one who has faith in Jesus.
59	Romans 5:6	For when we were still without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly.
60	Romans 5:7	For scarcely for a righteous man will one die; yet perhaps for a good man someone would even dare to die.
61	Romans 5:8	But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.
62	Romans 5:9	Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from wrath through Him.
63	Romans 5:10	For if when we were enemies we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His life.
64	Romans 6:22	But now having been set free from sin, and having become slaves of God, you have your fruit to holiness, and the end, everlasting life.
65	Romans 6:23	For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.
66	Romans 10:9	That if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.
67	Romans 10:10	For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.
68	Romans 10:11	For the Scripture says, "Whoever believes on Him will not be put to shame."
69	Romans 10:12	For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek, for the same Lord over all is rich to all who call upon Him.

70	Romans 10:13	For "whoever calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved."
71	Romans 11:24	For if you were cut out of the olive tree which is wild by nature, and were grafted contrary to nature into a cultivated olive tree, how much more will these, who are natural branches, be grafted into their own olive tree?
72	1 Corinthians 1:18	For the message of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God.
73	1 Corinthians 1:21	For since, in the wisdom of God, the world through wisdom did not know God, it pleased God through the foolishness of the message preached to save those who believe.
74	1 Corinthians 1:22	For Jews request a sign, and Greeks seek after wisdom;
75	1 Corinthians 1:23	but we preach Christ crucified, to the Jews a stumbling block and to the Greeks foolishness,
76	1 Corinthians 1:24	but to those who are called, both Jews and Greeks, Christ the power of God and the wisdom of God.
77	1 Corinthians 15:3	For I delivered to you first of all that which I also received: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures,
78	1 Corinthians 15:4	and that He was buried, and that He rose again the third day according to the Scriptures.
79	2 Corinthians 2:14	Now thanks be to God who always leads us in triumph in Christ, and through us diffuses the fragrance of His knowledge in every place.
80	2 Corinthians 2:15	For we are to God the fragrance of Christ among those who are being saved and among those who are perishing.
81	2 Corinthians 2:16	To the one we are the aroma of death leading to death, and to the other the aroma of life leading to life.
82	2 Corinthians 5:17	Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.
83	2 Corinthians 6:2	For He says: "In an acceptable time I have heard you, And in the day of salvation I have helped you." Behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation.
84	2 Corinthians 7:10	For godly sorrow produces repentance leading to salvation, not to be regretted; but the sorrow of the world produces death.
85	Galatians 1:3	Grace to you and peace from God the Father and our Lord Jesus Christ,
86	Galatians 1:4	who gave Himself for our sins, that He might deliver us from this present evil age, according to the will of our God and Father,
87	Galatians 1:5	to whom be glory forever and ever. Amen.
88	Ephesians 1:3	Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ,
89	Ephesians 1:4	just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before Him in love,
90	Ephesians 1:5	having predestined us to adoption as sons by Jesus Christ to Himself, according to the good pleasure of His will,
91	Ephesians 1:6	to the praise of the glory of His grace, by which He made us accepted in the Beloved.
92	Ephesians 1:7	In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace,
93	Ephesians 1:8	which He made to abound toward us in all wisdom and prudence,
94	Ephesians 1:9	having made known to us the mystery of His will, according to His good pleasure which He purposed in Himself,

95	Ephesians 1:10	that in the dispensation of the fullness of the times He might gather together in one all things in Christ, both which are in heaven and which are on earth-in Him.
96	Ephesians 1:11	In Him also we have obtained an inheritance, being predestined according to the purpose of Him who works all things according to the counsel of His will,
97	Ephesians 1:12	that we who first trusted in Christ should be to the praise of His glory.
98	Ephesians 1:13	In Him you also trusted, after you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation; in whom also, having believed, you were sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise,
99	Ephesians 1:14	who is the guarantee of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession, to the praise of His glory.
100	Ephesians 2:1	And you He made alive, who were dead in trespasses and sins,
101	Ephesians 2:2	in which you once walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit who now works in the sons of disobedience,
102	Ephesians 2:3	among whom also we all once conducted ourselves in the lusts of our flesh, fulfilling the desires of the flesh and of the mind, and were by nature children of wrath, just as the others.
103	Ephesians 2:4	But God, who is rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us,
104	Ephesians 2:5	even when we were dead in trespasses, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved),
105	Ephesians 2:6	and raised us up together, and made us sit together in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus,
106	Ephesians 2:7	that in the ages to come He might show the exceeding riches of His grace in His kindness toward us in Christ Jesus.
107	Ephesians 2:8	For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God,
108	Ephesians 2:9	not of works, lest anyone should boast.
109	Ephesians 2:10	For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them.
110	Ephesians 2:12	That at that time you were without Christ, being aliens from the commonwealth of Israel and strangers from the covenants of promise, having no hope and without God in the world.
111	Ephesians 2:13	But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ.
112	Colossians 1:19	For it pleased the Father that in Him all the fullness should dwell,
113	Colossians 1:20	and by Him to reconcile all things to Himself, by Him, whether things on earth or things in heaven, having made peace through the blood of His cross.
114	Colossians 1:21	And you, who once were alienated and enemies in your mind by wicked works, yet now He has reconciled
115	Colossians 1:22	in the body of His flesh through death, to present you holy, and blameless, and above reproach in His sight.
116	Colossians 2:13	And you, being dead in your trespasses and the uncircumcision of your flesh, He has made alive together with Him, having forgiven you all trespasses,
117	Colossians 2:14	having wiped out the handwriting of requirements that was against us, which was contrary to us. And He has taken it out of the way, having nailed it to the cross.

118	Colossians 2:15	Having disarmed principalities and powers, He made a public spectacle of them, triumphing over them in it.
119	1 Timothy 1:15	This is a faithful saying and worthy of all acceptance, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners, of whom I am chief.
120	1 Timothy 2:3	For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Savior,
121	1 Timothy 2:4	who desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.
122	1 Timothy 2:5	For there is one God and one Mediator between God and men, the Man Christ Jesus,
123	1 Timothy 2:6	who gave Himself a ransom for all, to be testified in due time,
124	2 Timothy 1:9	Who has saved us and called us with a holy calling, not according to our works, but according to His own purpose and grace which was given to us in Christ Jesus before time began,
125	2 Timothy 1:10	but has now been revealed by the appearing of our Savior Jesus Christ, who has abolished death and brought life and immortality to light through the gospel;
126	1 Thessalonians 5:8	But let us who are of the day be sober, putting on the breastplate of faith and love, and as a helmet the hope of salvation.
127	1 Thessalonians 5:9	For God did not appoint us to wrath, but to obtain salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ,
128	1 Thessalonians 5:10	who died for us, that whether we wake or sleep, we should live together with Him.
129	2 Thessalonians 2:13	But we are bound to give thanks to God always for you, brethren beloved by the Lord, because God from the beginning chose you for salvation through sanctification by the Spirit and belief in the truth,
130	2 Thessalonians 2:14	to which He called you by our gospel, for the obtaining of the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ.
131	2 Timothy 2:10	Therefore I endure all things for the sake of the elect, that they also may obtain the salvation which is in Christ Jesus with eternal glory.
132	2 Timothy 2:11	This is a faithful saying: For if we died with Him, we shall also live with Him.
133	2 Timothy 2:12	If we endure, we shall also reign with Him. If we deny Him, He also will deny us.
134	2 Timothy 2:13	If we are faithless, He remains faithful; He cannot deny Himself.
135	Titus 2:11	For the grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men,
136	Titus 2:12	teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly in the present age,
137	Titus 2:13	looking for the blessed hope and glorious appearing of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ,
138	Titus 2:14	who gave Himself for us, that He might redeem us from every lawless deed and purify for Himself His own special people, zealous for good works.
139	Titus 3:3	For we ourselves were also once foolish, disobedient, deceived, serving various lusts and pleasures, living in malice and envy, hateful and hating one another.
140	Titus 3:4	But when the kindness and the love of God our Savior toward man appeared,
141	Titus 3:5	not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to His mercy He saved us, through the washing of regeneration and renewing of the Holy Spirit,
142	Titus 3:6	whom He poured out on us abundantly through Jesus Christ our Savior,

143	Titus 3:7	that having been justified by His grace we should become heirs according to the hope of eternal life.
144	Hebrews 2:1	Therefore we must give the more earnest heed to the things we have heard, lest we drift away.
145	Hebrews 2:2	For if the word spoken through angels proved steadfast, and every transgression and disobedience received a just reward,
146	Hebrews 2:3	how shall we escape if we neglect so great a salvation, which at the first began to be spoken by the Lord, and was confirmed to us by those who heard Him,
147	Hebrews 2:4	God also bearing witness both with signs and wonders, with various miracles, and gifts of the Holy Spirit, according to His own will?
148	Hebrews 2:5	For He has not put the world to come, of which we speak, in subjection to angels.
149	Hebrews 2:6	But one testified in a certain place, saying: "What is man that You are mindful of him, Or the son of man that You take care of him?"
150	Hebrews 2:7	You have made him a little lower than the angels; You have crowned him with glory and honor, And set him over the works of Your hands.
151	Hebrews 2:8	You have put all things in subjection under his feet." For in that He put all in subjection under him, He left nothing that is not put under him. But now we do not yet see all things put under him.
152	Hebrews 2:9	But we see Jesus, who was made a little lower than the angels, for the suffering of death crowned with glory and honor, that He, by the grace of God, might taste death for everyone.
153	Hebrews 2:10	For it was fitting for Him, for whom are all things and by whom are all things, in bringing many sons to glory, to make the captain of their salvation perfect through sufferings.
154	Hebrews 2:11	For both He who sanctifies and those who are being sanctified are all of one, for which reason He is not ashamed to call them brethren,
155	Hebrews 2:12	saying: "I will declare Your name to My brethren; In the midst of the assembly I will sing praise to You."
156	Hebrews 2:13	And again: "I will put My trust in Him." And again: "Here am I and the children whom God has given Me."
157	Hebrews 2:14	Inasmuch then as the children have partaken of flesh and blood, He Himself likewise shared in the same, that through death He might destroy him who had the power of death, that is, the devil,
158	Hebrews 2:15	and release those who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage.
159	Hebrews 5:7	Who, in the days of His flesh, when He had offered up prayers and supplications, with vehement cries and tears to Him who was able to save Him from death, and was heard because of His godly fear,
160	Hebrews 5:8	though He was a Son, yet He learned obedience by the things which He suffered.
161	Hebrews 5:9	And having been perfected, He became the author of eternal salvation to all who obey Him,
162	Hebrews 7:25	Therefore He is also able to save to the uttermost those who come to God through Him, since He always lives to make intercession for them.
163	Hebrews 7:26	For such a High Priest was fitting for us, who is holy, harmless, undefiled, separate from sinners, and has become higher than the heavens;

164	Hebrews 7:27	who does not need daily, as those high priests, to offer up sacrifices, first for His own sins and then for the people's, for this He did once for all when He offered up Himself.
165	Hebrews 7:28	For the law appoints as high priests men who have weakness, but the word of the oath, which came after the law, appoints the Son who has been perfected forever.
166	Hebrews 11:6	But without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.
167	James 1:21	Therefore lay aside all filthiness and overflow of wickedness, and receive with meekness the implanted word, which is able to save your souls.
168	1 Peter 1:3	Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His abundant mercy has begotten us again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead,
169	1 Peter 1:4	to an inheritance incorruptible and undefiled and that does not fade away, reserved in heaven for you,
170	1 Peter 1:5	who are kept by the power of God through faith for salvation ready to be revealed in the last time.
171	1 Peter 1:6	In this you greatly rejoice, though now for a little while, if need be, you have been grieved by various trials,
172	1 Peter 1:7	that the genuineness of your faith, being much more precious than gold that perishes, though it is tested by fire, may be found to praise, honor, and glory at the revelation of Jesus Christ,
173	1 Peter 1:8	whom having not seen you love. Though now you do not see Him, yet believing, you rejoice with joy inexpressible and full of glory,
174	1 Peter 1:9	receiving the end of your faith - the salvation of your souls.
175	1 Peter 1:10	Of this salvation the prophets have inquired and searched carefully, who prophesied of the grace that would come to you,
176	1 Peter 1:11	searching what, or what manner of time, the Spirit of Christ who was in them was indicating when He testified beforehand the sufferings of Christ and the glories that would follow.
177	1 Peter 1:12	To them it was revealed that, not to themselves, but to us they were ministering the things which now have been reported to you through those who have preached the gospel to you by the Holy Spirit sent from heaven - things which angels desire to look into.
178	1 Peter 1:18	knowing that you were not redeemed with corruptible things, like silver or gold, from your aimless conduct received by tradition from your fathers,
179	1 Peter 1:19	but with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot.
180	1 Peter 1:20	He indeed was foreordained before the foundation of the world, but was manifest in these last times for you
181	1 Peter 1:21	who through Him believe in God, who raised Him from the dead and gave Him glory, so that your faith and hope are in God.
182	1 Peter 1:22	Since you have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit in sincere love of the brethren, love one another fervently with a pure heart,
183	1 Peter 1:23	having been born again, not of corruptible seed but incorruptible, through the word of God which lives and abides forever,
184	1 Peter 1:24	because "All flesh is as grass, and all the glory of man as the flower of the grass. The grass withers, and its flower falls away,

185	1 Peter 1:25	But the word of the Lord endures forever.” Now this is the word which by the gospel was preached to you.
186	1 John 1:8	If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us.
187	1 John 1:9	If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
188	1 John 3:1	Behold what manner of love the Father has bestowed on us, that we should be called children of God!
189	1 John 3:5	And you know that He was manifested to take away our sins, and in Him there is no sin.
190	1 John 3:6	Whoever abides in Him does not sin. Whoever sins has neither seen Him nor known Him.
191	1 John 4:9	In this the love of God was manifested toward us, that God has sent His only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through Him.
192	1 John 4:10	In this is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins.
193	Jude 24	Now to Him who is able to keep you from stumbling, and to present you faultless before the presence of His glory with exceeding joy,
194	Jude 25	To God our Savior, who alone is wise, be glory and majesty, dominion and power, both now and forever. Amen.
195	Revelation 3:20	Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears My voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and dine with him, and he with Me.
196	Revelation 7:9	After these things I looked, and behold, a great multitude which no one could number, of all nations, tribes, peoples, and tongues, standing before the throne and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, with palm branches in their hands,
197	Revelation 7:10	And crying out with a loud voice, saying, “Salvation belongs to our God who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb!”
198	Revelation 7:11	All the angels stood around the throne and the elders and the four living creatures, and fell on their faces before the throne and worshiped God,
199	Revelation 7:12	Saying: “Amen! Blessing and glory and wisdom, Thanksgiving and honor and power and might, Be to our God forever and ever. Amen.”
200	Revelation 19:1	After these things I heard a loud voice of a great multitude in heaven, saying, “Alleluia! Salvation and glory and honor and power belong to the Lord our God!
