2	2 Samuel	22:3	The God of my strength, in whom I will trust; My shield and the horn of my salvation, My stronghold and my refuge; My Savior, You save me from violence.
3	2 Samuel	22:4	I will call upon the Lord, who is worthy to be praised; So shall I be saved from my enemies.
4	2 Samuel	22:31	As for God, His way is perfect; The word of the Lord is proven; He is a shield to all who trust in Him.
5	2 Samuel	22:32	"For who is God, except the Lord? And who is a rock, except our God?"
6	2 Samuel	22:33	God is my strength and power, And He makes my way perfect.
7	2 Kings	6:15	And when the servant of the man of God arose early and went out, there was an army, surrounding the city with horses and chariots. And his servant said to him, "Alas, my master! What shall we do?"
8	2 Kings	6:16	So he answered, "Do not fear, for those who are with us are more than those who are with them."
9	2 Kings	6:17	And Elisha prayed, and said, "Lord, I pray, open his eyes that he may see." Then the Lord opened the eyes of the young man, and he saw. And behold, the mountain was full of horses and chariots of fire all around Elisha.
10	Job	13:15	Though He slay me, yet will I trust Him. Even so, I will defend my own ways before Him.
11	Job	13:16	He also shall be my salvation, For a hypocrite could not come before Him
12	Job	31:24	"If I have made gold my hope, Or said to fine gold, 'You are my confidence';
13	Job	31:25	If I have rejoiced because my wealth was great, And because my hand had gained much;
14	Job	31:26	If I have observed the sun when it shines, Or the moon moving in brightness,
15	Job	31:27	So that my heart has been secretly enticed, And my mouth has kissed my hand;
16	Job	31:28	This also would be an iniquity deserving of judgment, For I would have denied God who is above.
17	Psalms	2:12	Kiss the Son, lest He be angry, And you perish in the way, When His wrath is kindled but a little. Blessed are all those who put their trust in Him.
18	Psalms	4:6	There are many who say, "Who will show us any good?" Lord, lift up the light of Your countenance upon us.
19	Psalms	4:7	You have put gladness in my heart, More than in the season that their grain and wine increased.
20	Psalms	4:8	I will both lie down in peace, and sleep; For You alone, O Lord, make me dwell in safety.

21	Psalm	5:11	But let all those rejoice who put their trust in You; Let them ever shout for joy, because You defend them; Let those also who love Your name Be joyful in You.
22	Psalm	5:12	For You, O Lord, will bless the righteous; With favor You will surround him as with a shield.
23	Psalm	9:10	And those who know Your name will put their trust in You; For You, Lord, have not forsaken those who seek You.

37	Psalm	33:21	For our heart shall rejoice in Him, Because we have trusted in His holy name.
38	Psalm	33:22	Let Your mercy, O Lord, be upon us, Just as we hope in You.
39	Psalm	34:8	Oh, taste and see that the Lord is good; Blessed is the man who trusts in Him!
40	Psalm	34:22	The Lord redeems the soul of His servants, And none of those who trust in Him shall be condemned.
41	Psalm	36:7	How precious is Your lovingkindness, O God! Therefore the children of men put their trust under the shadow of Your wings.

42	Psalm	37:3	Trust in the Lord, and do good; Dwell in the land, and feed on His faithfulness.
43	Psalm	37:5	Commit your way to the Lord, Trust also in Him, And He shall bring it to pass.
44	Psalm	37:40	And the Lord shall help them and deliver them; He shall deliver them from the wicked, And save them, Because they trust in Him.
45	Psalm	38:15	For in You, O Lord, I hope; You will hear, O Lord my God.
46	Psalm	40:3	He has put a new song in my mouth— Praise to our God; Many will see it and fear, And will trust in the Lord.
47	Psalm	40:4	Blessed is that man who makes the Lord his trust, And does not respect the proud, nor such as turn aside to lies.
48	Psalm	42:11	Why are you cast down, O my soul? And why are you disquieted within me? Hope in God; For I shall yet praise Him, The help of my countenance and my God.
49	Psalm	44:6	For I will not trust in my bow, Nor shall my sword save me.
50	Psalm	52:8	But I am like a green olive tree in the house of God; I trust in the mercy of God forever and ever.
51	Psalm	55:23	But You, O God, shall bring them down to the pit of destruction; Bloodthirsty and deceitful men shall not live out half their days; But I will trust in You.
52	Psalm	56:3	Whenever I am afraid, I will trust in You.
53	Psalm	56:11	In God I have put my trust; I will not be afraid. What can man do to me?
54	Psalm	57:1	Be merciful to me, O God, be merciful to me! For my soul trusts in You; And in the shadow of Your wings I will make my refuge, Until these calamities have passed by.
55	Psalm	61:4	I will abide in Your tabernacle forever; I will trust in the shelter of Your wings.
56	Psalm	62:8	Trust in Him at all times, you people; Pour out your heart before Him; God is a refuge for us.
57	Psalm	62:10	Do not trust in oppression, Nor vainly hope in robbery; If riches increase, Do not set your heart on them.
58	Psalm	64:10	The righteous shall be glad in the Lord, and trust in Him. And all the upright in heart shall glory.
59	Psalm	71:1	In You, O Lord, I put my trust; Let me never be put to shame.
60	Psalm	71:14	But I will hope continually, And will praise You yet more and more.
61	Psalm	71:5	For You are my hope, O Lord GOD; You are my trust from my youth.
62	Psalm	73:28	But it is good for me to draw near to God; I have put my trust in the Lord GOD, That I may declare all Your works.
63	Psalm	91:2	I will say of the Lord, "He is my refuge and my fortress; My God, in Him I will trust."
64	Psalm	115:1	Not unto us, O Lord, not unto us, But to Your name give glory,

			Because of Your mercy, Because of Your truth.
65	Psalm	115:2	Why should the Gentiles say, "So where is their God?"
66	Psalm	115:3	But our God is in heaven; He does whatever He pleases.
67	Psalm	115:4	Their idols are silver and gold, The work of men's hands.
68	Psalm	115:5	They have mouths, but they do not speak; Eyes they have, but they do not see;
69	Psalm	115:6	They have ears, but they do not hear; Noses they have, but they do not smell;
70	Psalm	115:7	They have hands, but they do not handle; Feet they have, but they do not walk; Nor do they mutter through their throat.
71	Psalm	115:8	Those who make them are like them; So is everyone who trusts in them.
72	Psalm	115:9	O Israel, trust in the Lord; He is their help and their shield.
73	Psalm	115:10	O house of Aaron, trust in the Lord; He is their help and their shield.
74	Psalm	115:11	You who fear the Lord, trust in the Lord; He is their help and their shield.
75	Psalm	118:8	It is better to trust in the Lord Than to put confidence in man.
76	Psalm	118:9	It is better to trust in the Lord Than to put confidence in princes.
77	Psalm	119:42	So shall I have an answer for him who reproaches me, For I trust in Your word.
78	Psalm	119:114	You are my hiding place and my shield; I hope in Your word.
79	Psalm	119:116	Uphold me according to Your word, that I may live; And do not let me be ashamed of my hope.
80	Psalm	119:147	I rise before the dawning of the morning, And cry for help; I hope in Your word.
81	Psalm	125:1	Those who trust in the Lord Are like Mount Zion, Which cannot be moved, but abides forever.
82	Psalm	130:5	I wait for the Lord, my soul waits, And in His word I do hope.
83	Psalm	130:7	O Israel, hope in the Lord; For with the Lord there is mercy, And with Him is abundant redemption.
84	Psalm	135:18	Those who make them are like them; So is everyone who trusts in them.
85	Psalm	143:8	Cause me to hear Your lovingkindness in the morning, For in You do I trust; Cause me to know the way in which I should walk, For I lift up my soul to You.
86	Psalm	146:3	Do not put your trust in princes, Nor in a son of man, in whom there is no help.
87	Psalm	146:5	Happy is he who has the God of Jacob for his help, Whose hope is in the Lord his God,
88	Psalm	147:11	The Lord takes pleasure in those who fear Him, In those who hope in His mercy.
89	Proverbs	3:5	Trust in the Lord with all your heart, And lean not on your own understanding;
90	Proverbs	10:28	The hope of the righteous will be gladness, But the expectation

			of the wicked will perish.
91	Proverbs	11:28	He who trusts in his riches will fall, But the righteous will flourish like foliage.
92	Proverbs	13:12	Hope deferred makes the heart sick, But when the desire comes, it is a tree of life.
93	Proverbs	16:20	He who heeds the word wisely will find good, And whoever trusts in the Lord, happy is he.
94	Proverbs	23:18	For surely there is a hereafter, And your hope will not be cut off.
95	Proverbs	24:14	So shall the knowledge of wisdom be to your soul; If you have found it, there is a prospect, And your hope will not be cut off.
96	Proverbs	28:25	He who is of a proud heart stirs up strife, But he who trusts in the Lord will be prospered.
97	Proverbs	28:26	He who trusts in his own heart is a fool, But whoever walks wisely will be delivered.
98	Proverbs	29:25	The fear of man brings a snare, But whoever trusts in the Lord shall be safe.
99	Proverbs	30:5	Every word of God is pure; He is a shield to those who put their trust in Him.
100	Isaiah	8:17	And I will wait on the Lord, Who hides His face from the house of Jacob; And I will hope in Him.
101	Isaiah	12:2	Behold, God is my salvation, I will trust and not be afraid; 'For Yah, the Lord, is my strength and song; He also has become my salvation.'"
102	Isaiah	26:3	You will keep him in perfect peace, Whose mind is stayed on You, Because he trusts in You.
103	Isaiah	26:4	Trust in the Lord forever, For in YAH, the Lord, is everlasting strength.
104	Isaiah	31:1	Woe to those who go down to Egypt for help, And rely on horses, Who trust in chariots because they are many, And in horsemen because they are very strong, But who do not look to the Holy One of Israel, Nor seek the Lord!
105	Isaiah	42:17	They shall be turned back, They shall be greatly ashamed, Who trust in carved images, Who say to the molded images, 'You are our gods.'
106	Isaiah	50:10	"Who among you fears the Lord? Who obeys the voice of His Servant? Who walks in darkness And has no light? Let him trust in the name of the Lord And rely upon his God.
107	Isaiah	51:5	My righteousness is near, My salvation has gone forth, And My arms will judge the peoples; The coastlands will wait upon Me, And on My arm they will trust.
108	Jeremiah	3:23	Truly, in vain is salvation hoped for from the hills, And from the multitude of mountains; Truly, in the Lord our God Is the salvation of Israel.
109	Jeremiah	12:5	"If you have run with the footmen, and they have wearied you, Then how can you contend with horses? And if in the land of

			peace, In which you trusted, they wearied you, Then how will you do in the floodplain of the Jordan?
110	Jeremiah	17:5	Thus says the Lord: “Cursed is the man who trusts in man And makes flesh his strength, Whose heart departs from the Lord.
111	Jeremiah	17:7	“Blessed is the man who trusts in the Lord, And whose hope is the Lord.
112	Jeremiah	17:8	For he shall be like a tree planted by the waters, Which spreads out its roots by the river, And will not fear when heat comes; But its leaf will be green, And will not be anxious in the year of drought, Nor will cease from yielding fruit.
113	Jeremiah	17:13	O Lord, the hope of Israel, All who forsake You shall be ashamed. “Those who depart from Me Shall be written in the earth, Because they have forsaken the Lord, The fountain of living waters.”
114	Jeremiah	29:11	For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the Lord, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope.
115	Jeremiah	29:12	Then you will call upon Me and go and pray to Me, and I will listen to you.
116	Jeremiah	29:13	And you will seek Me and find Me, when you search for Me with all your heart.
117	Lamentations	3:22	Through the Lord’s mercies we are not consumed, Because His compassions fail not.
118	Lamentations	3:23	They are new every morning; Great is Your faithfulness.
119	Lamentations	3:24	“The Lord is my portion,” says my soul, “Therefore I hope in Him!”
120	Lamentations	3:25	The Lord is good to those who wait for Him, To the soul who seeks Him.
121	Lamentations	3:26	It is good that one should hope and wait quietly For the salvation of the Lord.
122	Ezekiel	33:13	When I say to the righteous that he shall surely live, but he trusts in his own righteousness and commits iniquity, none of his righteous works shall be remembered; but because of the iniquity that he has committed, he shall die.
123	Ezekiel	37:11	Then He said to me, “Son of man, these bones are the whole house of Israel. They indeed say, ‘Our bones are dry, our hope is lost, and we ourselves are cut off!’
124	Ezekiel	37:12	Therefore prophesy and say to them, ‘Thus says the Lord God: “Behold, O My people, I will open your graves and cause you to come up from your graves, and bring you into the land of Israel.
125	Ezekiel	37:13	Then you shall know that I am the Lord, when I have opened your graves, O My people, and brought you up from your graves.
126	Daniel	3:28	Nebuchadnezzar spoke, saying, “Blessed be the God of Shadrach, Meshach, and Abed-Nego, who sent His Angel and

			delivered His servants who trusted in Him, and they have frustrated the king's word, and yielded their bodies, that they should not serve nor worship any god except their own God!
127	Nahum	1:7	The Lord is good, A stronghold in the day of trouble; And He knows those who trust in Him.
128	Habakkuk	2:18	"What profit is the image, that its maker should carve it, The molded image, a teacher of lies, That the maker of its mold should trust in it, To make mute idols?"
129	Mark	10:24	And the disciples were astonished at His words. But Jesus answered again and said to them, "Children, how hard it is for those who trust in riches to enter the kingdom of God!"
130	John	14:1	"Let not your heart be troubled; you believe in God, believe also in Me.
131	John	14:2	In My Father's house are many mansions; if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you.
132	John	14:3	And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, there you may be also.
133	Romans	5:2	through whom also we have access by faith into this grace in which we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God.
134	Romans	5:3	And not only that, but we also glory in tribulations, knowing that tribulation produces perseverance;
135	Romans	5:4	and perseverance, character; and character, hope.
136	Romans	5:5	Now hope does not disappoint, because the love of God has been poured out in our hearts by the Holy Spirit who was given to us.
137	Romans	8:18	For I consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us.
138	Romans	8:19	For the earnest expectation of the creation eagerly waits for the revealing of the sons of God.
139	Romans	8:20	For the creation was subjected to futility, not willingly, but because of Him who subjected it in hope;
140	Romans	8:21	because the creation itself also will be delivered from the bondage of corruption into the glorious liberty of the children of God.
141	Romans	8:24	For we were saved in this hope, but hope that is seen is not hope; for why does one still hope for what he sees?
142	Romans	8:25	But if we hope for what we do not see, we eagerly wait for it with perseverance.
143	Romans	15:4	For whatever things were written before were written for our learning, that we through the patience and comfort of the Scriptures might have hope.
144	Romans	15:12	And again, Isaiah says: "There shall be a root of Jesse; And He who shall rise to reign over the Gentiles, In Him the Gentiles shall hope."

145	Romans	15:13	Now may the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that you may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.
146	1 Corinthians	13:13	And now abide faith, hope, love, these three; but the greatest of these is love.
147	1 Corinthians	15:16	For if the dead do not rise, then Christ is not risen.
148	1 Corinthians	15:17	And if Christ is not risen, your faith is futile; you are still in your sins!
149	1 Corinthians	15:18	Then also those who have fallen asleep in Christ have perished.
150	1 Corinthians	15:19	If in this life only we have hope in Christ, we are of all men the most pitiable.
151	2 Corinthians	1:9	Yes, we had the sentence of death in ourselves, that we should not trust in ourselves but in God who raises the dead,
152	2 Corinthians	1:10	who delivered us from so great a death, and does deliver us; in whom we trust that He will still deliver us,
153	2 Corinthians	3:4	And we have such trust through Christ toward God.
154	2 Corinthians	3:5	Not that we are sufficient of ourselves to think of anything as being from ourselves, but our sufficiency is from God,
155	Ephesians	1:11	In Him also we have obtained an inheritance, being predestined according to the purpose of Him who works all things according to the counsel of His will,
156	Ephesians	1:12	that we who first trusted in Christ should be to the praise of His glory.
157	Ephesians	1:13	In Him you also trusted, after you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation; in whom also, having believed, you were sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise,
158	Ephesians	2:12	that at that time you were without Christ, being aliens from the commonwealth of Israel and strangers from the covenants of promise, having no hope and without God in the world.
159	Ephesians	2:13	But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ.
160	Philippians	3:13	Brethren, I do not count myself to have apprehended; but one thing I do, forgetting those things which are behind and reaching forward to those things which are ahead,
161	Philippians	3:14	I press toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus.
162	Philippians	3:20	For our citizenship is in heaven, from which we also eagerly wait for the Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ,
163	Philippians	3:21	who will transform our lowly body that it may be conformed to His glorious body, according to the working by which He is able even to subdue all things to Himself.
164	Colossians	1:27	To them God willed to make known what are the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles: which is Christ in you, the hope of glory.
165	Colossians	1:28	Him we preach, warning every man and teaching every man in

			all wisdom, that we may present every man perfect in Christ Jesus.
166	1 Thessalonians	4:13	But I do not want you to be ignorant, brethren, concerning those who have fallen asleep, lest you sorrow as others who have no hope.
167	1 Thessalonians	4:14	For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so God will bring with Him those who sleep in Jesus.
168	1 Thessalonians	4:15	For this we say to you by the word of the Lord, that we who are alive and remain until the coming of the Lord will by no means precede those who are asleep.
169	1 Thessalonians	4:16	For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of an archangel, and with the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first.
170	1 Thessalonians	4:17	Then we who are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And thus we shall always be with the Lord.
171	1 Thessalonians	4:18	Therefore comfort one another with these words.
172	1 Thessalonians	5:8	But let us who are of the day be sober, putting on the breastplate of faith and love, and as a helmet the hope of salvation.
173	1 Thessalonians	5:9	For God did not appoint us to wrath, but to obtain salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ
174	1 Timothy	6:17	Command those who are rich in this present age not to be haughty, nor to trust in uncertain riches but in the living God, who gives us richly all things to enjoy.
175	Titus	2:11	For the grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men,
176	Titus	2:12	teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly in the present age,
177	Titus	2:13	looking for the blessed hope and glorious appearing of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ,
178	Titus	2:14	who gave Himself for us, that He might redeem us from every lawless deed and purify for Himself His own special people, zealous for good works.
179	Hebrews	6:19	This hope we have as an anchor of the soul, both sure and steadfast, and which enters the Presence behind the veil,
180	Hebrews	6:20	where the forerunner has entered for us, even Jesus, having become High Priest forever according to the order of Melchizedek.
181	Hebrews	7:19	for the law made nothing perfect; on the other hand, there is the bringing in of a better hope, through which we draw near to God.
182	Hebrews	10:19	Therefore, brethren, having boldness to enter the Holiest by the blood of Jesus,
183	Hebrews	10:20	by a new and living way which He consecrated for us, through

			the veil, that is, His flesh,
184	Hebrews	10:21	and having a High Priest over the house of God,
185	Hebrews	10:22	let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water.
186	Hebrews	10:23	Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for He who promised is faithful.
187	Hebrews	11:13	These all died in faith, not having received the promises, but having seen them afar off were assured of them, embraced them and confessed that they were strangers and pilgrims on the earth.
188	1 Peter	1:3	Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His abundant mercy has begotten us again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead,
189	1 Peter	1:4	to an inheritance incorruptible and undefiled and that does not fade away, reserved in heaven for you,
190	1 Peter	1:5	who are kept by the power of God through faith for salvation ready to be revealed in the last time.
191	1 Peter	1:13	Therefore gird up the loins of your mind, be sober, and rest your hope fully upon the grace that is to be brought to you at the revelation of Jesus Christ;
192	1 Peter	1:14	as obedient children, not conforming yourselves to the former lusts, as in your ignorance;
193	1 Peter	1:15	but as He who called you is holy, you also be holy in all your conduct, 16 because it is written, "Be holy, for I am holy."
194	1 Peter	1:18	knowing that you were not redeemed with corruptible things, like silver or gold, from your aimless conduct received by tradition from your fathers,
195	1 Peter	1:19	but with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot.
196	1 Peter	1:20	He indeed was foreordained before the foundation of the world, but was manifest in these last times for you
197	1 Peter	1:21	who through Him believe in God, who raised Him from the dead and gave Him glory, so that your faith and hope are in God.
198	1 Peter	3:15	But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts, and always be ready to give a defense to everyone who asks you a reason for the hope that is in you, with meekness and fear;
199	1 John	3:2	Beloved, now we are children of God; and it has not yet been revealed what we shall be, but we know that when He is revealed, we shall be like Him, for we shall see Him as He is.
200	1 John	3:3	And everyone who has this hope in Him purifies himself, just as He is pure.
